The new MET of IRRI seeks to establish a systematic, sequential, multistage, and multi-environment testing (MET) system for elite rice lines in order to improve overall breeding efficiency. • Sowing: Dec 9, 2013 and Transplanting: Dec 30, 2013

• Hybrids: 1 plant per hill (Inbred CK: 3 plants per hill)

• Plant population per plot = 250

• Plot size: 12 m² and plant space: 20 (row) x 20 (plant) cm

• Fertilizer: 150-30-30kg N-P-K/ha
